

Eagle Lacrosse Fee vs Cost to Play

Comparison for 2016 to 2017

2016 Season Price to Pay (younger player)

Registration Fee+Sandwich Sale or Buyout Fee
\$90+30 sandwiches or \$60
2016 Fee = \$150

2016 Season Price to Pay (older player)

Registration Fee+Sandwich Sale or Buyout Fee
\$110+30 sandwiches or \$60
2016 Fee = \$170

2017 Season Price to Pay (younger player)

Registration Fee ONLY
No Mandatory Fundraiser or Buyout
2017 Fee = \$125

2017 Season Price to Pay (older player)

Registration Fee ONLY
No Mandatory Fundraiser or Buyout
Total = \$175

Why are 2017 rates higher?

1. For 2017 we have simplified the process to eliminate the required fundraiser or buyout based on feedback from parents.
2. One price based on the cost per player
3. We have added the ability to fundraise with multiple fundraisers to provide for the ability to increase the chance of reducing or even zeroing out the fees.

The option is there for you to do so if you and/or your family put in the effort to raise more money.
